Tipp City Public Library Code of Conduct:

To provide a pleasant, orderly facility conducive to concentrated and effective use of Library materials and service, disruptive behavior will not be permitted.

This includes disorderly conduct or activities whether intentional or inadvertent that interferes with the rights of others, physical abuse, abusive or threatening language, and misuse of library furnishings.

The library staff will enforce these rules:

- Soliciting is prohibited.
- Possession, sale, or use of alcoholic beverage and/or illegal substances is prohibited.
- Possessing firearms either concealed or in plain view, in the Library, unless the person in possession of the weapon is a law enforcement officer, is prohibited.
- Persons committing theft, vandalism, or other illegal acts (on library property) are subject to prosecution.
- Smoking, using tobacco, or using electronic nicotine delivery systems or similar products, such as e-cigarettes, in the library or within 50 feet of the public entrance is prohibited.
- Skateboarding is not permitted on library property.
- Persons entering the library must be wearing proper attire including shirt and shoes.
- The library reserves the right to inspect any suspicious bags, purses, briefcases, backpacks, and overcoats for library materials and/or call the authorities.
- Taking photographs and/or recording videos of Library staff or patrons without their permission is prohibited.
- Children age 10 and under may not be left unattended in the Library. Parents and/or responsible persons (age 15 or older) are accountable for their children's behavior while in the Library. Parents and/or responsible persons must be within sight of the children. Unattended children age 10 and under who remain at the Library at closing time may be turned over to police custody.

Expulsion from the library, loss of library privileges, and/or legal prosecution may result when a violation occurs.
